A Storytelling Objective: (Use your exploratory questions to formulate a 2-3 sentence statement describing what your story will accomplish.)

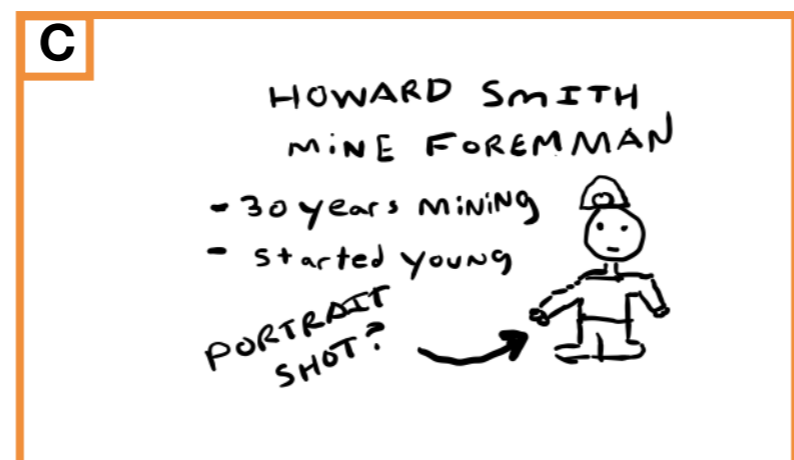
Show readers what it is like to explore an old Pennsylvanian Cole mine.

Scenes/Notes (Sketch and make notes of possible scenes, views, key moments, key people, perspectives, important information ordered by priority, concepts, questions, etc.)



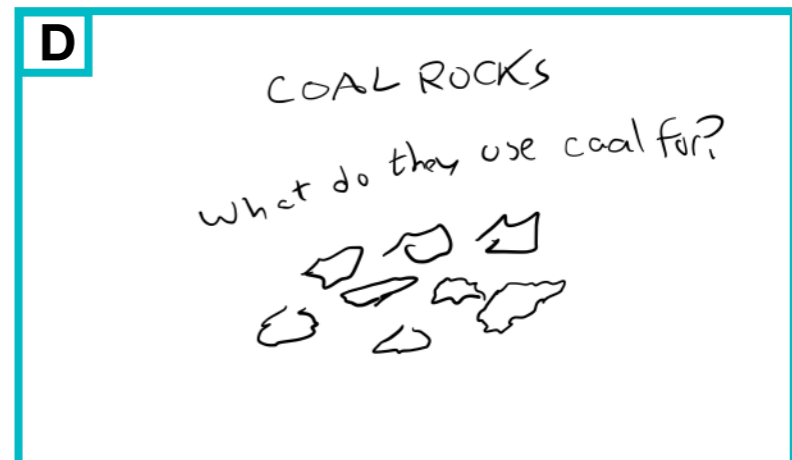
Open with a wide view description of the train and mine near the mountains.

How much does it cost?*



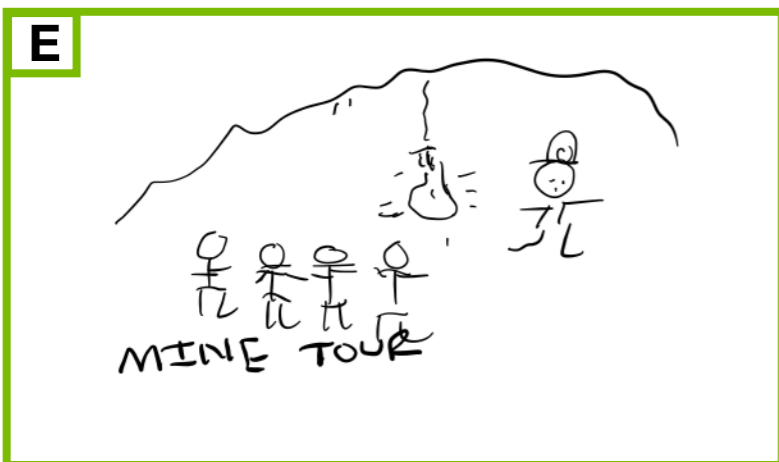
I could write a description showing how Smith looks, the way he dresses.

3rd Grade class tours mine on Wednesday at 11 a.m.

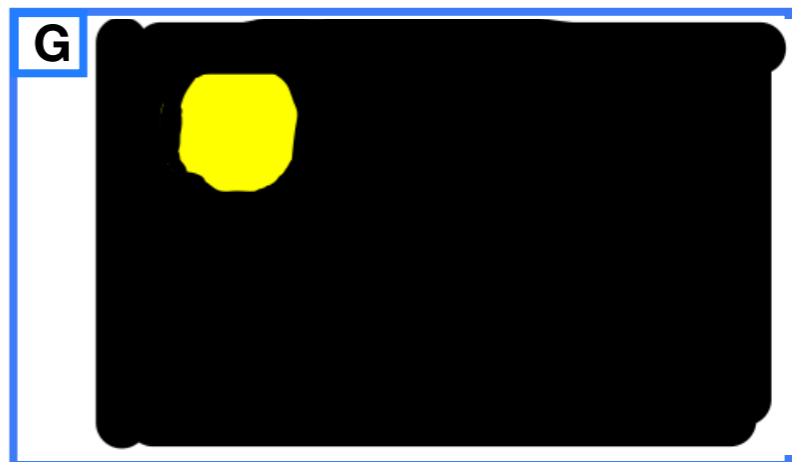
Canaries?
